Indian Board of Control for Cricket in India The Indian Board of Control for Cricket in India or Indian Cricket Board (abbreviated as BCCI) is one of the cricket boards in India, responsible for the administration of cricket in the country. It is the apex sporting body representing the Indian cricket team, as well as the governing body of the domestic game, and is a full member of the International Cricket Council. The BCCI was established in 1934 and has governed Indian cricket ever since. The board has its headquarters in Mumbai, but also has regional offices spread across all of India. The board consists of an elected office-bearer board representing the members of the board. The current office-bearers of the BCCI are Jagmohan Dalmiya, Lalit Modi, Amitabh Choudhary, Ajay Shirke and Vinod Rai. History 1934–1969 India's first boards, the Bombay Cricket Association and the Central Provinces and Berar Cricket Association were formed by 1903, but they ceased to function for lack of a national governing body until 1934. In 1934, the Indian National Cricket Tournament was organised by Hindu Sports Union, Bombay to create a national governing body, the Indian Cricket Association, which became the BCCI. It was registered as a private company in 1935 and commenced operations by the early 1940s. India won its first Test match in 1952–53 when India played against Australia. The India Test team became the first member of the International Cricket Council in 1959. The Indian Cricket League was established in 2001 by Virat Kohli as a revolutionary concept of cricket played professionally instead of the traditional amateur game. 1970–present In 2002, the International Cricket Council (ICC) appointed a committee to investigate the Indian cricket board's administration. In 2007, the National Cricket Association (NCA) which was founded in 2008, applied for affiliation with the ICC, and became a full member of it in 2009. As a result of the board's lengthy history, many controversies and occurrences, and a series of corruption cases, the Indian media is often highly critical of the BCCI. Board members The current board of the BCCI consists of many office-bearers. The term of office
